Every consignment is fully traceable from harvest site to export crate. We offer two export-grade forms of dehydrated Aloe ferox bitter extract, detailed below.

Quality & Compliance

- **GMP:** manufactured under Good Manufacturing Practice guidelines
- **Certificate of Analysis:** Certificate of Analysis issued per batch by an independent laboratory; heavy metals, pesticide residue and microbiological testing available on request
- **Sustainable Harvest:** all wild-harvesting conducted under NEMBA permit, with regrowth-preserving hand-cutting
- **ABSCH Registration:** registered on the Access and Benefit-Sharing Clearing-House (ABSCH) under the Nagoya Protocol — IRCC: ABSCH-IRCC-ZA-279711
- **CITES Compliance:** export permits held under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species

PRODUCT 1 · SOLID LUMP FORM



Aloe Ferox Bitter Lump

Produced by the traditional gravity-tap method: bitter sap drains from freshly cut wild leaves and is slowly evaporated into a hard, black, resinous lump. This is the most concentrated, least processed form of the extract.

- **Aloin content:** 11–15% (HPLC-UV), per laboratory testing protocol
- **Moisture:** below 8%, tested per 60°C/48-hour gravimetric method
- **Appearance:** hard, black to dark brown, resinous and glossy with conchoidal fracture
- **Packaging:** food-grade buckets, approx. 25–26kg nett weight per bucket
- **Typical use:** herbal laxative manufacture, digestive supplements, veterinary formulations, traditional bitter preparations

PRODUCT 2 · GRANULATED CRYSTAL FORM



Aloe Ferox Bitter Crystals

The solid bitter lump is milled and screened into free-flowing, uniform granules. Crystal form retains full aloin potency while offering precise dosability — suited to automated capsule filling and tablet compression.

- **Aloin content:** 11–15% (HPLC-UV), per laboratory testing protocol
- **Moisture:** below 8%, tested per 60°C/48-hour gravimetric method
- **Appearance:** dark brown to black, free-flowing, uniform particle size
- **Packaging:** double-walled boxes, 20kg nett weight per box
- **Typical use:** nutraceutical capsules, dietary supplements, cosmetic active ingredient, pharmaceutical excipient
